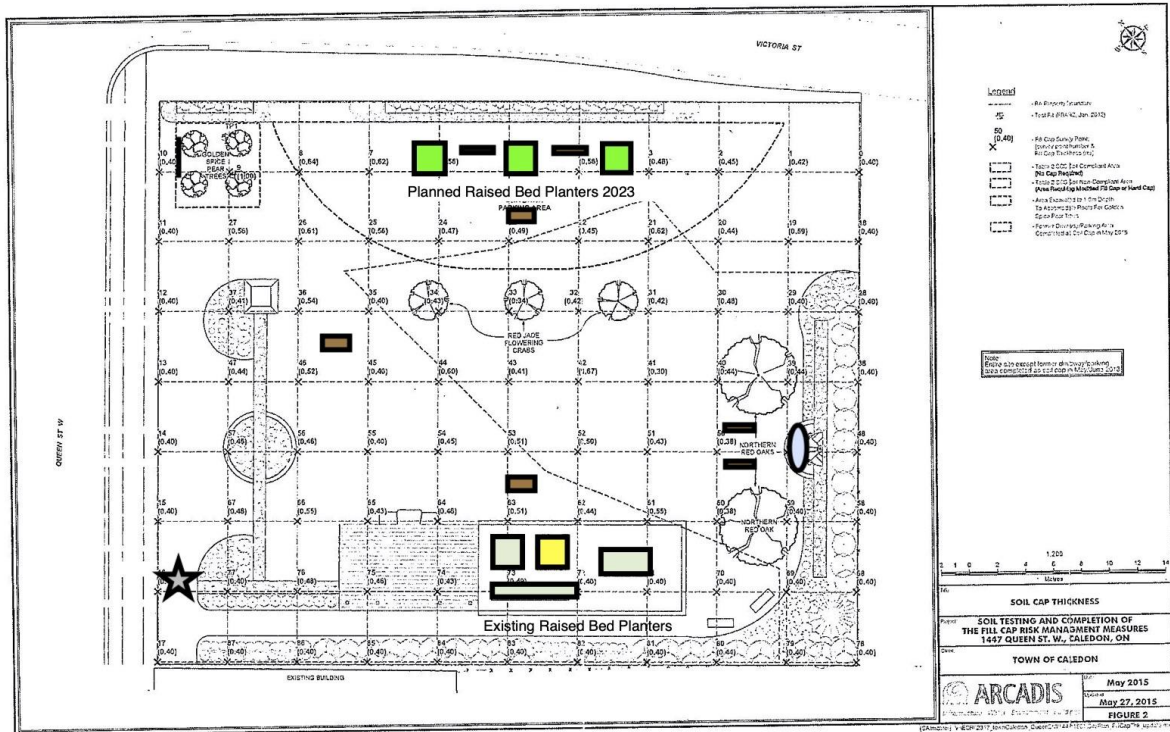


Alton Village Square

Layout - Alton Village Square

The bright green boxes are the raised beds proposed for 2023. The light green boxes are the existing raised vegetable raised beds, the yellow is the new pollinator garden planted in

2022. The blue oval is the water feature that began operating in 2022 and the handcrafted birdhouse is located here, behind the wall, as well. The star in the left hand corner is the new Heritage Caledon Plaque and stone, where we would like to replace some of the turf with small native flowers and grasses. In the top left corner is the proposed location for the Alton Village Square Sign.

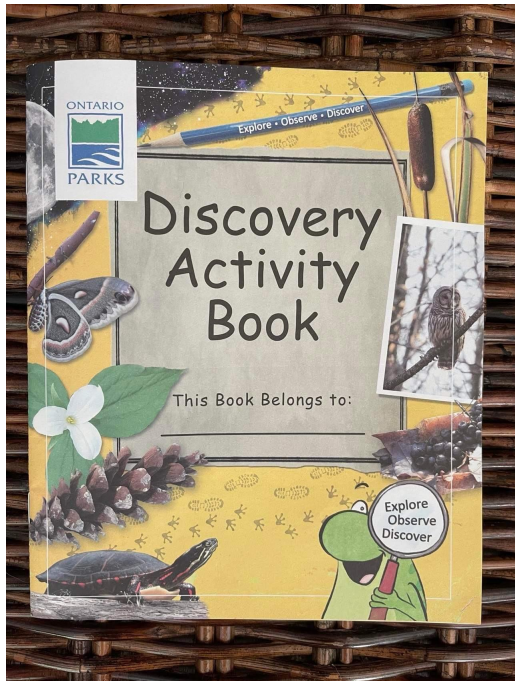

 - Biodiversity support (various animals)
 - Carbon sequestration (CO₂ and trees)
 - Erosion control (tree roots)
 - Resources for wildlife (bird)

Right Side Icons:
 - Food security (bowl of food)
 - Resilient ecosystems (globe)
 - Raw material production (factory and bottle)
 - Recreation (person walking)
 - Soil health (seedling)
 - Water filtration (water drop)
